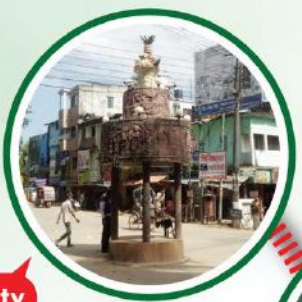
Jute Crafts of Bangladesh

Bangladesh is one of the world's top producers of jute, a type of fiber derived from plants in the Corchorus genus. Jute is amazingly versatile and is relatively affordable, as it has a fast growth rate and is not overly fussy about the terrain in which it is grown. It has long been used for industrial, agricultural and household purposes and is prized as a raw material for use in various crafts in Bangladesh. One of the traditional uses for jute is in the manufacture of the shika – a multi-purpose storage bag that is hung from the ceiling in the home, making the most of available space. Small shikas are used to store bottles, jars and even pots in the kitchen, while larger shikas containing quilts and blankets are hung from the ceilings during the summer months when these are not needed. Beautifully decorated dolnas – a type of hammock – made from jute are used as cradles for babies.

In the skilled hands of women, an intricate tracery of braided design emerge from the long silken skeins of jute, to create bagds, table mats, wall hangings, floor mats and numerous other articles. Finely woven braids or plain golden strands are knotted or coiled to produce a wealth of motifs, which are deftly linked together to create new patterns. Solid squares, circles and hexagons are used as frequently as the traditional motifs of fruits and flowers to create products of charm and utility. Like most crafts the jute products of today have their origin in the utility and articles of rural Bangladesh. Bangladesh's jute industry is in a position of strength to participate in development. Especially with the recent innovations and investments in this industry it has become possible to produce specialised jute products for international markets.

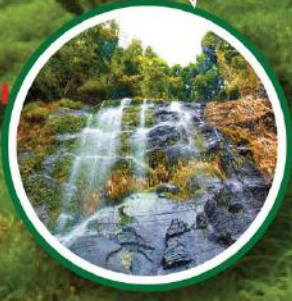

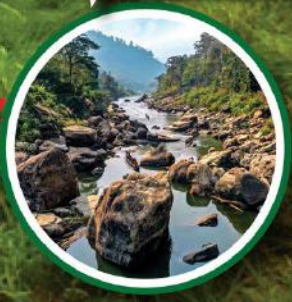

TRACKING MAP of Bandarban

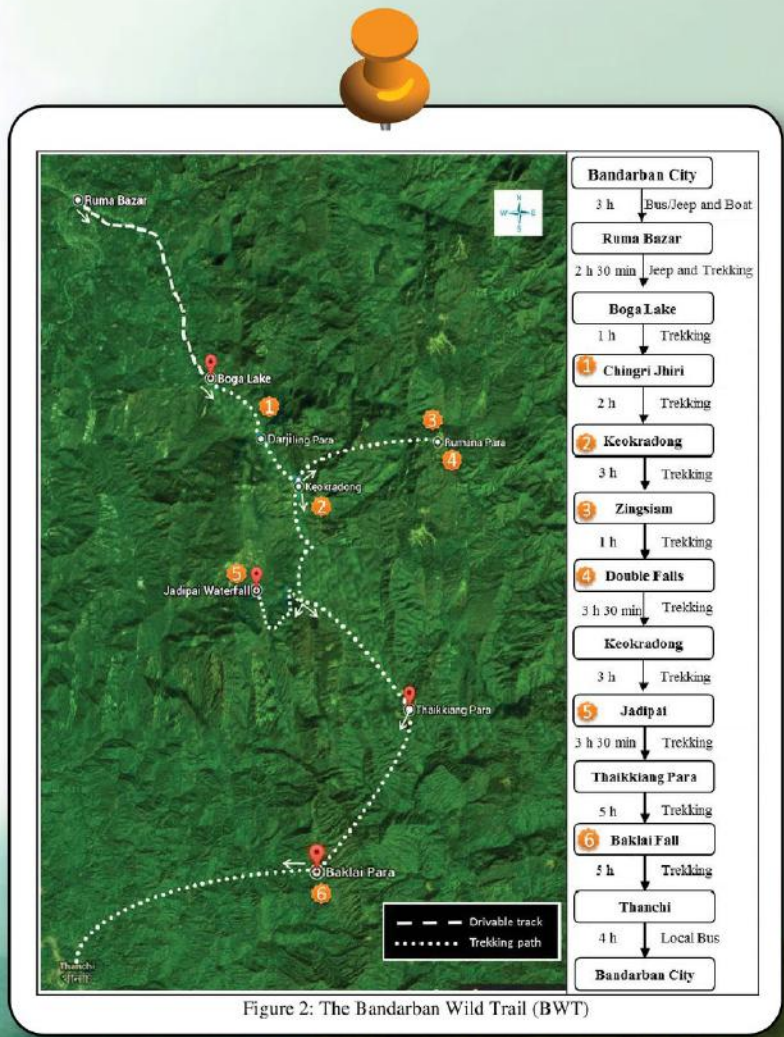


Figure 2: The Bandarban Wild Trail (BWT)

Tracking Tour In Bangladesh

Tracking in Bangladesh is an exciting adventure that gives visitors the opportunity to appreciate the amazing beauty of Bangladesh's natural areas. Both locals and visitors to Bangladesh enjoying the many hiking trails on offer - through the hills, beneath shady forest canopies, beside rivers and across the mangroves, there are numerous opportunities for hiking in Bangladesh.

A popular track in Bangladesh is to Keokradong, one of the higher peaks in the country's mountain range. For some people the enjoyment comes from the challenge of nearing the peak; for others it is meeting the tribal people and experiencing their culture. The Chittagong Hills offer number of tracking routes in Bangladesh.

Many tour operators offer tracks with experienced guides. Guides will be able to provide you with an abundance of information on the surroundings. Tracks may last one day to several days and cover short and long distances. If you are planning on tracking in Bangladesh, it is recommended that you see your medical practitioner before departing (See Health Advice). Ensure that you will be fit enough to handle the track. People often train for a month or so before leaving. It is important to tell your guide if you have any medical problems. You should also carry a small medical kit with you when tracking.

A day pack or hiking bag with several pockets and good padding is ideal for tracking in Bangladesh. It is also important that you wear comfortable shoes. For longer hikes you should make use of tracking/hiking boots that are worn in and waterproof. Thick socks that draw moisture away from the skin are excellent for hiking. Other things to carry with you include a water bottle, multi-tool, rain coat, sun hat, toiletries, flashlight, sunglasses and plastic bags. You will definitely want to bring along a camera to record your adventure. Binoculars are a good idea – especially for those keen on identifying birds.



POHELA BOISHAKH

Bangali New Year

Pohela Boishakh is the first day of the Bengali calendar which is also the official calendar of Bangladesh. TRIBAL FESTIVAL



The Biju festival is celebrated over 3 days.

The **first day** is called Phool Biju and is observed by offering floral tributes to the nearby rivers. Houses are specially cleaned and decorated with flowers. Lamps are lit in Buddhist temples and Chakma households with prayers being offered to the Buddha.

The **second day** is called Mul Biju and is celebrated with traditional dances and songs. Special delicacies and sweets are prepared. People spend the day paying visits to their friends and extended families. Traditional games are played by all. The day culminates with the special Bizhu dance that ushers out the old year and welcomes in the new year. Dancers are dressed in traditional attire. The dance is accompanied by the rhythms of traditional musical instruments which include percussion and flute, some of which are crafted out of bamboo. The **third day** is called Gotche Potche Biju where elders in the community are honored with an elaborate feast with marriage ceremonies to their spouses. **The Biju festival brings together the entire Chakma community. Recently, it has seen an upsurge in popularity among people from other states too who visit Tripura during the Biju festival to enjoy the festivities.**

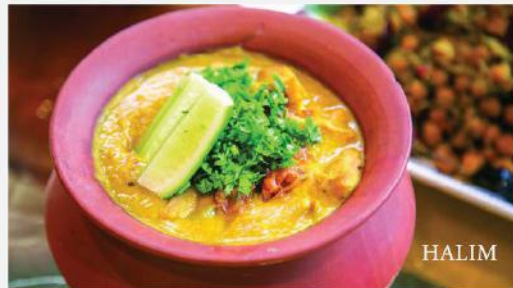

Nakshi Pitha is a piece of special dough sculpted into art via a bamboo stick or a small metal plate moulded into a v shape, this Pitha is a beautiful piece of art originating from the rural part of Bangladesh.

Bhapa Pitha

Bhapa pitha is a popular sweet snack amongst Bengali and Assamese people. It is delicate, soft, and contain various forms of texture with a fusion of rich flavour as you bite into the pitha.



DUDH PULI

Dudh puli is a traditional bengali pithe or pitha and Makar Sankranti or poush sankranti (in Bengal) is the best time to make it at home. Bengali style Dudh puli means half-moon shaped stuffed rice cake or dumpling cooked in dudh or milk. In this bengali dudh puli recipe sweet coconut-jaggery stuffed rice cake or dumpling is cooked in jaggery mixed milk. But it's not that common jaggery rather it's a winter special bengali date palm jaggery knows as nolen gur or notun khejur gur in bengali.



PATISHAPTA Pitha

Patishapta pitha recipe is one of the most renowned and scrumptious Bengali pitha recipes which is compulsorily prepared in every Bengali house during "Poush Parbon". In short, "Makar Sankranti" is incomplete without patishapta for bengalis. It is hugely popular in West Bengal and Bangladesh. Bengali patishapta recipe is a type of stuffed pancake where coconut-mawa-jaggery stuffing is placed on an all-purpose flour-rice flour-semolina battered crepe and folded to a roll. It is mostly served as snacks with tea but can be relished at any time of the day to satisfy your craving.



Shital Pati is the traditional art of making a hand-crafted mat by weaving together strips of a green cane known as 'Murta'. The mat is used by people all over Bangladesh as a sitting mat, bedspread or prayer mat. The main bearers and practitioners are weavers living mostly in the low-lying villages in the greater Sylhet region of Bangladesh, but there are also pockets of Shital Pati weavers in other areas of the country. Both men and women participate in collecting and processing Murta, with women being more involved in the weaving process. The craft is a major source of livelihood and a strong marker of identity; primarily a family-based craft, it helps to reinforce family bonding and create a harmonious social atmosphere. Mastery of the technique commands social prestige, and the practice empowers underprivileged communities, including women. The government promotes awareness of the element through local and national craft fairs, and Shital Pati communities are increasingly being organized into cooperatives to ensure the efficient safeguarding and transmission of the craft and guarantee its profitability. Safeguarding efforts involve the direct participation of the communities concerned and the practice is primarily transmitted from generation to generation within the families of craftspeople.

SHITAL PATI



Sitalpati are made from cane or from murta plants, known in different places as mostak, patipata, patibet and paitara. The murta plant grows around water bodies in Sylhet, Sunamganj, Barisal, Tangail, Comilla, Noakhali, Feni and Chittagong. Nakshi pati made of murta plants is available only in Sylhet and Noakhali districts of Bangladesh. In India, Sitalpati is made in the northern Cooch Behar district of the state of West Bengal. Among the areas of Cooch Behar where Sitalpatis are woven, Sagareswar, Ghugumari and Pashnadanga are important centres.

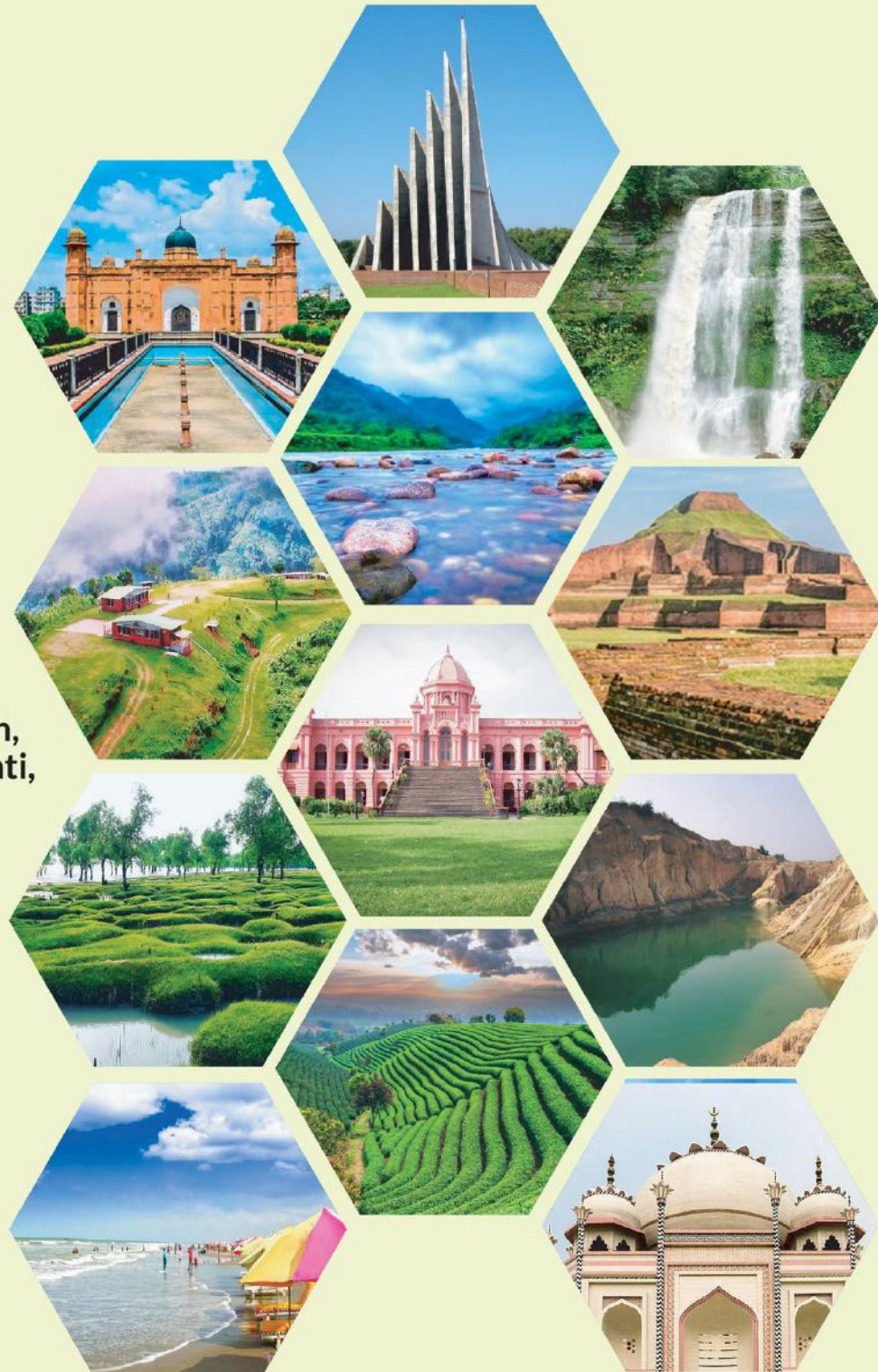



Nakshi kantha



Nakshi kantha, a type of embroidered quilt, is a centuries-old Bengali art tradition of the Bengal region, notable in Bangladesh and Indian states of West Bengal, Tripura and part of Assam. The basic material used is thread and old cloth. Nakshi kanthas are made throughout Bangladesh, but the greater Mymensingh, Jamalpur, Bogra, Rajshahi, Faridpur and Jessore, Chittagong areas are most famous for this craft

The colourful patterns and designs that are embroidered resulted in the name "Nakshi Kantha", which was derived from the Bengali word "naksha", which refers to artistic patterns. The early kanthas had a white background accented with red, blue and black embroidery; later yellow, green, pink and other colours were also included. The running stitch called "kantha stitch" is the main stitch used for the purpose. Traditionally, kantha was produced for the use of the family. Today, after the revival of the nakshi kantha, they are produced commercially.





DURGA PUJA

Durga Puja is celebrated all over Bangladesh. Some perform it individually, some collectively. Collective puja is called baroyari or sarvajanin (open to all). People of all castes can participate in Durga Puja. A sarvajanin Durga Puja is celebrated at dhakeswari temple in dhaka. It is also celebrated in more than a hundred temples in the city. The puja celebrations at the ramakrishna mission, Dhaka, and Jagannath Hall of the university of dhaka are also famous. In Dhaka the Durga images are carried to the buriganga to be immersed. On the occasion, food and clothes are distributed among the poor.

SHAKRAIN FESTIVAL

Shakrain Festival is an annual celebration in Dhaka, Bangladesh, observed with the flying of kites. It occurs at the end of Poush, the ninth month of the Bengali calendar. This day is known as Poush Sangkranti. Shakrain Festival is one of the oldest annual festivals of Bangladesh. **Why is Shakrain celebrated?** It is a symbol of unity and friendship in Bangladesh. Shakrain is celebrated mostly around the southern part of Dhaka city. As part of the celebration, colorful kites are flown high from the rooftops around the area in the afternoon.



SHOLAKIA EIDGHA MAIDAN

Every year, Sholakia Eidgha Maidan turns into a gathering place for Muslims. People offer prayers and seek blessings from Allah for their peace and happiness.

BUDDHA PURNIMA

The Buddha Purnima, also referred to as Boishakhi Purnima, is the largest religious festival in Bangladesh held by the Buddhist community. It is celebrated annually on the full moon day that lies in the first month of the Bangla Calendar. Boishakh, which occurs in May according to the Gregorian calibration, marks the occurrence of three important events of the Blessed One's life, including birth, his enlightenment, and his death. During this full moon day, Buddhists all around the country commemorate it in several ways. Some of the most common activities include:

- Flying the Buddhist and national flags at the tops of temples
- Chanting the discourses of the Tipitaka
- The people hold sermons discussing the life of Buddha and recite meaningful scriptures
- Group meditation events

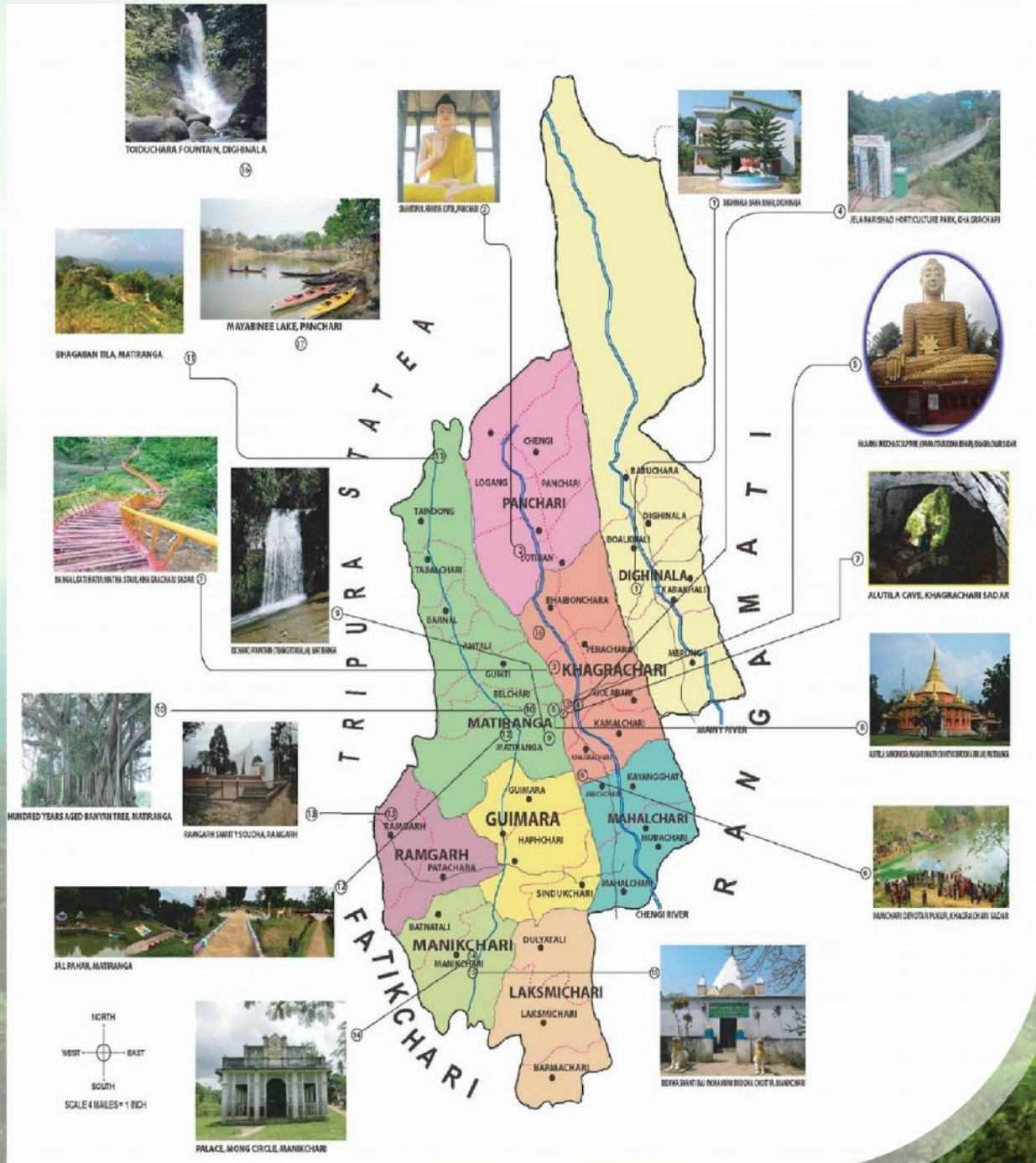

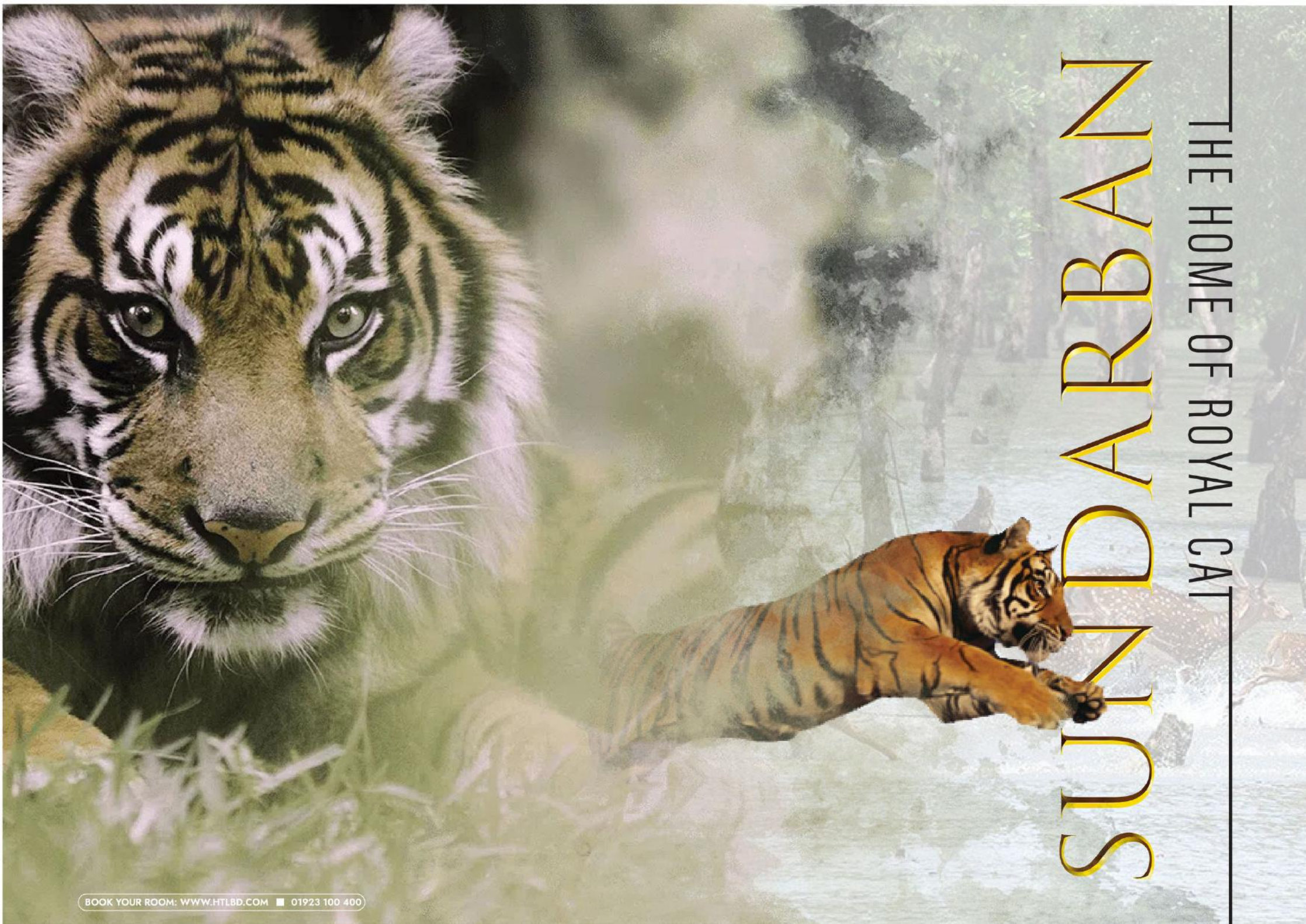

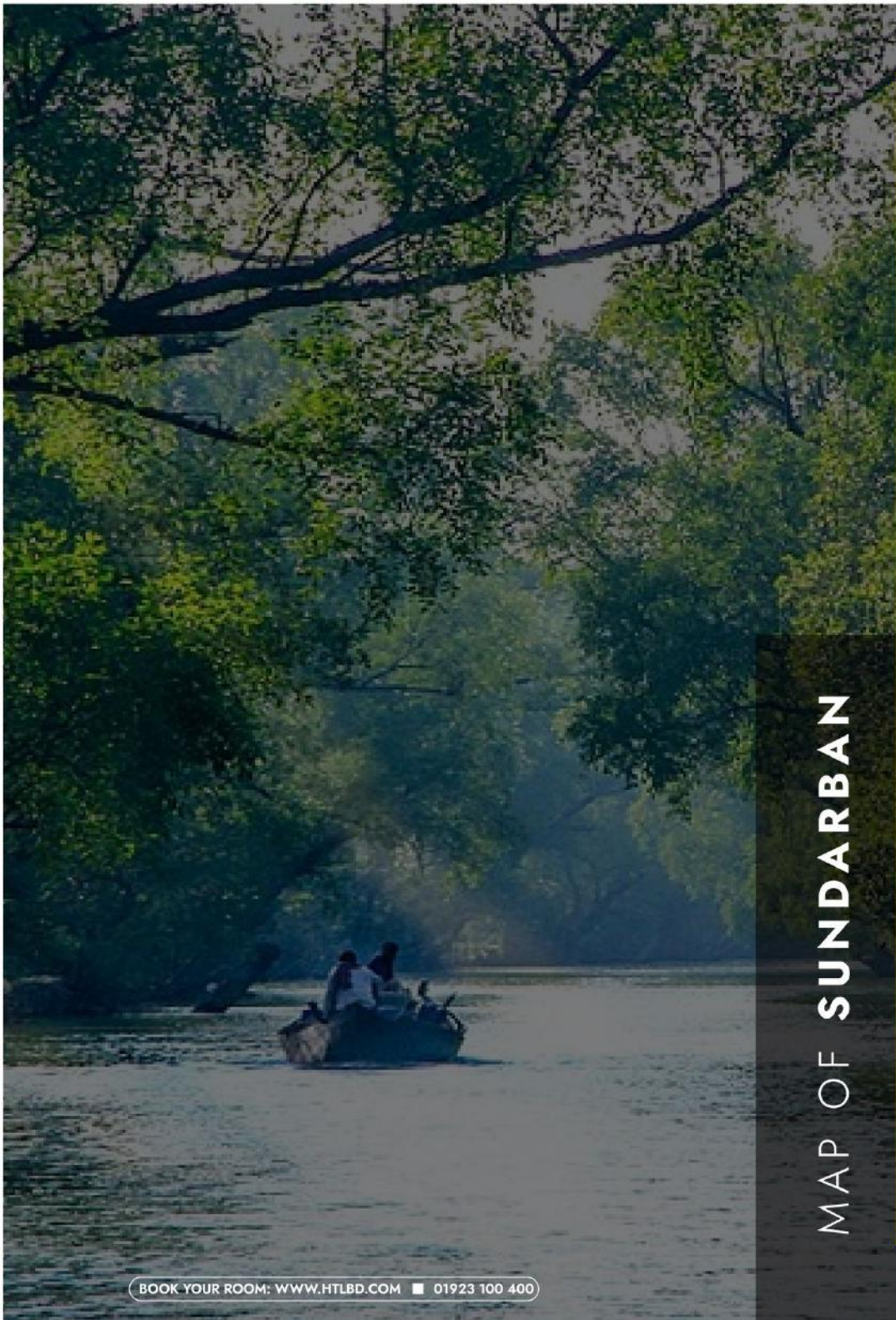

SUNDARBAN

The Sundarbans, one of the most attractive places in Bangladesh, is the largest mangrove forest in the world. Visitors feel great enthusiasm and fascination to come to this nature's bounties of exceptional character. The forest is a World Heritage Site for its extra-ordinary vegetation and diverse ecological balance. No other tidal forests can match it in terms of diversity. Wonderful flora and fauna, divergent wildlife, paramount beauty of green canopy, thousands of meandering Streams, rivers, creeks made this forest one of the great eco-tourism attractions. The forest is famous as the primitive abode of the royal Bengal Tiger, the strongest, and most beautiful wild animal of the world.

The Sundarbans is a mangrove area in the delta formed by the confluence of the Ganges, Brahmaputra, and Meghna Rivers in the Bay of Bengal. It spans from the Hooghly River in India's state of West Bengal to the Baleswar River in Bangladesh. It comprises closed and open mangrove forests, agriculturally used land, mudflats, and barren land, and is intersected by multiple tidal streams and channels. Four protected areas in the Sundarbans are enlisted as UNESCO World Heritage Sites, viz Sundarbans National Park, Sundarbans West, Sundarbans South, and Sundarbans East Wildlife Sanctuaries. The Sundarbans mangrove forest covers an area of about 10,000 km² (3,900 sq mi), of which forests in Bangladesh's Khulna Division extend over 6,017 km² (2,323 sq mi) and in West Bengal, they extend over 4,260 km² (1,640 sq mi) across the South 24 Parganas and North 24 Parganas districts. The most abundant tree species are sundri (*Heritiera fomes*) and gewa (*Excoecaria agallocha*). The forests provide habitat to 453 faunal wildlife, including 290 birds, 120 fish, 42 mammals, 35 reptiles, and eight amphibian species.





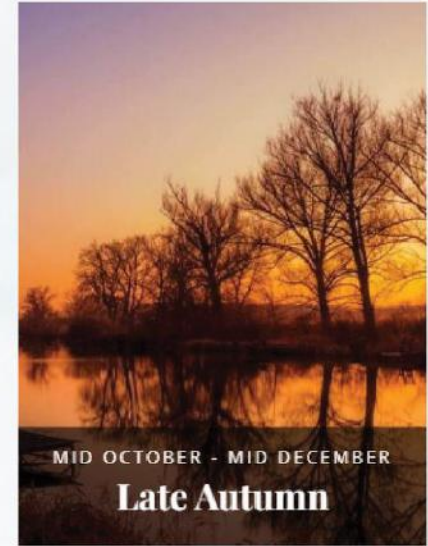
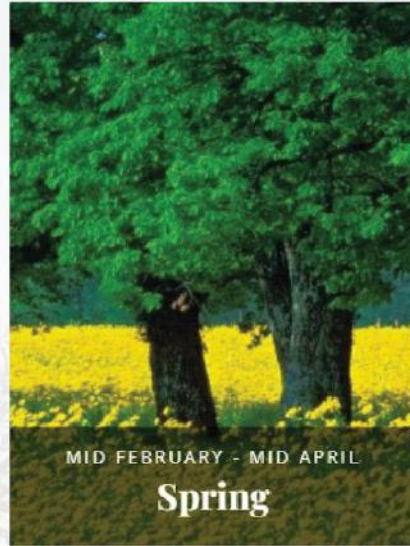
MAP OF SUNDARBAN
